WHEREAS: The State of Georgia and the nation of Israel have enjoyed a long and prosperous relationship,

with Israel maintaining a consular presence in Georgia since 1956 and Georgia having

representation in Israel since 1994; and

WHEREAS: This relationship has yielded both great cultural and economic benefits to both parties. In 2021

alone, Georgia exported over \$280 million worth of goods to Israel and imported nearly \$652

million worth of goods to the state from this valued partner and ally; and

WHEREAS: The friendship and shared values between Georgia and Israel have continued to grow in recent

years, as both our cultural and economic bonds have strengthened through efforts such as the launch of the Georgia – Israel Legislative Caucus, the expansion of air service to include direct flights between Atlanta and Tel Aviv as of May 2023, and robust exchanges of Georgia's law enforcement professionals with Israel through the Georgia International Law Enforcement

Exchange (GILEE); and

WHEREAS: This year, a bipartisan group of legislators comprised of Sen. Kay Kirkpatrick, Rep. Debra

Bazemore, Rep. Michael Gravley, Rep. Debbie Buckner, Rep. Karen Bennett, Rep. Barry Fleming, Rep. Mitchell Kaye, Rep. Darlene Taylor, Mr. Brent Cox, and their families will travel from Georgia to Israel to further learn about and celebrate the deep ties between these two

nations; and

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia applauds the efforts of this group and wishes them Godspeed as they

visit our close friend and ally Israel and reaffirms our support for the Jewish State; now
